Baltic – American Dialog program

The Baltic-American Dialogue program is designed to foster the exchange of ideas between the Baltic States and the U.S. and to stimulate international collaboration on topics of mutual interest.

Public organizations are invited to apply for funds to host speakers from the U.S. to travel to the Baltics. BAFF funding will provide successful applicant organizations with financial support to sponsor American speakers on topics of mutual importance and interest. Funding is designed to cover logistics expenses, such as international airfare, local lodging and meals, and regional transportation. This program is designed to provide support for programs that could not be held without this funding.

Applications will be accepted for funding of up to \$10,000 USD. The upper limit may be adjusted for program proposals to take place in multiple venues across the Baltics. Funds will be dispersed as required, based on the schedule provided in the grant application.
